OPERATIONS

In December 1960, the 101st Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron was one of five newly activated units assigned to the Maine Air National Guard at Dow AFB. All maintenance personnel previously assigned to the augmented 132nd Fighter Squadron had been reassigned to the 101st Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron

In March 1964, the 101st Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron was recognized by the National Guard Bureau for having the second lowest error rating (.2%) in maintenance reporting of the 88 ANG maintenance squadrons. In December 1966, the 101st Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron received a superior rating during the Operational Readiness Inspection. During August 1971, the Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron load crew won top honors in the Quarterly Weapons Loading Competition established by the 21st Air Division. The team won the competition with a perfect score of 2,000 points - the first ever recorded.

In recognition of its outstanding contribution to the accident prevention program and its significant achievement in the field of safety, the 101st Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron was awarded the 101st Fighter Interceptor Ground Safety Plaque for 1973.

During the month of August 1977, after undergoing extensive modification over a period of nine months, the Air Guard hangar was back in service. The modification allowed the unit's new KC-135 to be brought into the hangar for inspection and repair.
