The primary mission of the 107 Services Flight is to support this unit's beddown requirements by mobilizing Prime RIBS (Readiness in Base Services). Depending on location and population, primary services support may be either an initial or augmentation team that can operate from fixed facilities or in a field environment.

Day to day the Services Flight plans menus and prepares meals for the unit. They arrange billeting for personnel outside commuting distance for drills and annual field training. They keep all mobility equipment in serviceable condition and ready to deploy. Training of the Services Flight personnel in all areas of responsibility to include food services, billeting, laundry services, exchange services and mortuary affairs.
