Nine members of the 108 Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron (CAMS) supported the US Army at the Army Depot in Bayonne, N.J. during October 1990. They saved several hundred thousand dollars by repainting sixty M-1A1 Abrams main battle tanks in desert camouflage colors,

Three people from the 177th Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, Explosive Ordinance Disposal Section, were activated on 2 February 1991.
