111th Army Air Forces Base Unit (Search Attack and Staging) B-24 and B-17 crews and radar operators were processed at an ever increasing rate. In August they began arriving weekly. When the Eastern Technical Training Command assumed jurisdiction of Langley Field on September 15, 1944, the LAB and H2X courses merged into one course entitled Radar Observer Bombardment. By October Langley had furnished 512 complete crews to Eighth Air Force and 266 crews to

Fifteenth Air Force.
