Because of the Berlin Crisis in Germany, as of 1 Oct 1961, by direction of the President, under authority conferred by Public Law 117 of the 87th Congress, 113th Armament and Electronics Maintenance Squadron was ordered to extended active duty for 12 months, unless sooner relieved by proper authority, at Andrews.

In Feb 1962, the 121st deployed to Myrtle Beach, S.C. for four weeks of weapons training with the 354th Tactical Fighter Wing. The purpose was for training with conventional and special weapons delivery. The Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron and the Armament and Electronics Squadron participated.
