From 1967 the 116th Food Service Section has been under several commands, beginning with the 116th Combat Support Group, followed by the 116th Combat Support Squadron, and the 116th Civil Engineering Squadron. In 1993, the Food Service Section was reorganized and renamed the 116th Services Flight and placed under the command of the 116th Support Group. Previous commanders of this Flight were Capt George R. Asinc, Capt Tom Odum, Maj Jackie Vann, Maj Dan Zachman, Maj William Fletcher, Maj Paul Lewis. Since 1996 the unit has been under the command of Maj Deborah J. Nazimiec. As a Flight, the unit is not authorized a First Sergeant but the full-time technician, SMSgt Wayne Bradford keeps the unit on track.

The 116th Services Flight has made many deployments, some with the Wing and numerous others independent of the Wing due mainly because of the strong demand for the specialists in the Flight. Significant training deployments in 1989 were Jamaica, and then Spain during the same year; 1990, Alaska; 1991, Turkey and various locations in support of DESERT STORM, and in 1994 to

Germany. Also in 1994 the entire unit was put under State Active Duty to support flood relief in South Georgia. A number of unit members volunteered to support the 1996 World Olympics in Atlanta. Another state activation for the unit was to support relief from Hurricane Floyd 1999. Later that year the Services Flight deployed to Utah for the exercise GLOBAL PATRIOT.
