OPERATIONS

The lineage of the 142 Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron goes back to the 123 Fighter Squadron. Immediately after World War II, all aircraft maintenance was performed by mechanics assigned to that squadron. On May 24, 1946, the 123 Utility Flight was formed in order to perform maintenance on support aircraft. Maintenance on the F-51 fighter was accomplished by Detachment A, 242 Air Service Group (Fighter).

November 1, 1950 reorganization created the 142 Maintenance and Supply Group, and on March 1, 1951, additional reorganization created separate maintenance and supply squadrons.
