## **EMBLEM**

On a disc Azure, a sword palewise point to base Silver Gray, surmounted by a checkered diamond, Argent and Sable, fimbriated Gules, flanked by two lightning bolts, one bendwise and one bend sinisterwise Or, all within a narrow border White. Attached above the disc, a Scarlet scroll edged with a narrow White border and inscribed "RACERS" in White letters. Attached below the disc, a Scarlet scroll edged with a narrow White border and inscribed "137TH INTELLIGENCE SQUADRON" in White letters.

## **EMBLEM SIGNIFICANCE**

Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The sword signifies a capability for unleashing devastating power. The scarlet diamond denotes the historical patriotism and strength of the unit since it began in 1954. The checkered diamond represents unity of the unit's past, present and future. The two lightning

bolts suggest the ability to strike forcefully and quickly when dealing with the enemy. The field represents the unit's courage, strength, and valor against all dangers.
