Constituted in the National Guard in 1921 as 17th Balloon Group Headquarters, assigned to the IX Corps, and allotted to the state of California. Redesignated as Headquarters, 38th Balloon Group on 25 January 1923. Unit placed on the deferred list 2 July 1923 as a Deferred National Guard (DNG) unit, and replaced in the mobilization plan by the 52nd Balloon Group (DNG). Redesignated as Headquarters, 138th Balloon Group in 1924. Withdrawn from the National Guard on 17 September 1927 and demobilized.
