## OPERATIONS

In the latter months of 1964, the Department of Defense approved the establishment of seven new ANG support units. They consisted of an Air Weather Squadron located at Langley AFB, Virginia, and six Air Weather Flights at Air Division level. One of the flights was assigned

to Tennessee's 30 Armored Division and located at Berry Field as the 205 Weather Flight.

On 18 September 1965, Federal Recognition was granted to the new 205th Weather Flight at Berry Field. Capt David B. Herbert and two others were transferred to the 205 Weather Flight from the 105 Weather Flight, also at Berry Field. The 205 Weather Flight is subordinate to the newly activated 200 Weather Squadron at Langley AFB, Virginia.
