"To me, the redesignation is something for the history books, but the professionals here will produce the same excellence," said Cpt. Bradley Allen, who assumed command of the new 314th Maintenance Operations Flight during the June 1 redesignation ceremony. Reporting to the 314th Maintenance Group, the 30-person flight will continue overseeing support and maintenance of the 314th AW's 28 C-130s used for Little Rock's training mission.
