

# **349<sup>th</sup> RECRUITING SQUADRON**

## **MISSION**

The mission of the 349th Recruiting Squadron is to plan and execute United States Air Force recruiting programs to recruit sufficient high-quality civilian candidates to satisfy USAF manpower requirements. The squadron recruits in a broad range of programs including enlisted, line officer, and health professions. The annual budget of the squadron is more than \$1.2 million. The 349th has 109 people authorized: 4 officers, 95 enlisted, and ten civilians. Currently, the 349th has 103 people assigned. The squadron's personnel are assigned to 43 different locations across a four-state area. This total includes squadron headquarters, 5 Health Professions recruiting offices, 8 flight offices, 33 EA recruiting offices, 2 Officer Training School recruiting offices, and 2 Military Entrance Processing Stations. The squadron's geographic area of responsibility includes most of Oklahoma, the southern half of Kansas, and the western half of Arkansas and Missouri - a total of 113,936 square miles.
