Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 31 March 1924 as Headquarters, 351st Pursuit Group, assigned to the General Headquarters Reserve, and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Initiated on 8 May 1926 with headquarters at Decatur, IL. Relocated on 7 January 1927 to Milwaukee, WI. Inactivated 20 March 1929 at Milwaukee by relief of personnel. Reorganized and redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 351st Bombardment Group on 1 October 1933. Disbanded 31 May 1942.
