

351st SUPPLY SQUADRON



MISSION

The Supply Squadron's primary mission is to provide timely logistics (supply and fuel) support required to successfully perform the various missions of the wing and its tenant organizations. Roughly 30,000 on-hand supply line items are maintained in a 150,000-square-foot storage space, which is being enlarged to accommodate even more line items. Adequate fuel is stored to provide fuel support for assigned and transient equipment.

About 156 military and civilian workers are assigned to Supply. The Supply Squadron provides support to more than 32 units on and off base, including ROTC detachments in Missouri and Kansas, two satellite Air National Guard units, one Reserve unit, and recruiters in several Missouri cities. Squadron personnel determine the source of supply, order the item, update and follow up on supply status, validate requirements, and deliver property to the user. Requests range from pencils to complex missile components and refueling operations.
