Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 352nd Balloon Company, assigned to the 61st Balloon Group (redesignated as the 561st Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the First Corps Area. Initiated on 2 November 1921 at Boston, MA. Withdrawn from the First Corps Area on 11 January 1927 and allotted to the Fifth Corps Area. Inactivated on 1 February 1927 at Boston by relief of personnel. Reorganized by December 1927 at Dayton, OH. Inactivated by March 1930 at Dayton by relief of personnel. Redesignated as the 352nd Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
