Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 362nd Squadron (Observation), assigned to the XVI Corps and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Initiated on 22 September 1922 at Racine, WI. Redesignated as the 362nd Observation Squadron on 25 January 1923. Assigned on 31 March 1924 to the 334th Observation Group (XVI Corps). Inactivated on 1 December 1929 at Racine by relief of personnel. Conducted summer training at Selfridge Field, MI, and Chanute Field, IL. Designated mobilization station was Selfridge Field, MI. Demobilized on 1 October 1933.
