Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 370th Balloon Company, assigned to the 66th Balloon Group (redesignated as the 566th Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Seventh Corps Area. Initiated in February 1922 at St. Joseph, MO. Relocated on 26 May 1926 to Kansas City, MO. Redesignated as the 370th Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Conducted annual summer training at Scott Field, IL. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
