EMBLEM



On a disc tierced in pairle reversed Azure, Argent and Silver Gray, in dexter a flight symbol palewise point to chief Gules, in sinister a griffin sergeant Or, enraged of the second, head White, eyed Sable, in base an aerial bomb bendwise sinister nose downward and a mechanic's wrench in saltire open end upwards Silver Gray, shaded Black, highlighted White, all within a narrow border Black. Attached above the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "VIRES PER ACCURATIUM" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "419TH MAINTENANCE SQUADRON" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The flight symbol represents support of the flying mission of the wing. The griffin refers to the unit's affiliation with the wing. The wrench symbolizes the maintenance of aircraft and the building of bombs. The bomb reflects part of the unit's mission. The entire emblem portrays the ability to deploy globally wherever and whenever needed.
