Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 15 October 1921 as the 466th Squadron (Headquarters), assigned to the Fifth Army and allotted to the Fifth Corps Area. Initiated in April 1922 at Dayton, OH. Redesignated as the 466th Headquarters Squadron on 25 January 1923. Conducted summer training at Wright Field, OH, Camp Dodge, IA, or Camp Perry, OH. Withdrawn from the Fifth Corps Area on 28 November 1928. Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
