EMBLEM

The emblem is symbolic of the Squadron, and the Air Force colors, ultramarine blue and golden yellow, are used. The color blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations, and yellow to the excellence of Air Force personnel in performing duties. The flight symbol represents both airframes and allied maintenance, and reflects the spirit of the Division, while the wings and globe allude to the Command. The orbits symbolize the armament and electronic systems of the Squadron's operation, while the hexagon refers to small tools and fastening devices. (Approved, 24 Oct 1967)
