Unlike ANG units (like the 106th Observation Sq mentioned above), Organized Reserve units were frequently mostly "paper" units serving as holding units for officers. I believe most (if not all) were disbanded in May 1942 and their personnel assigned to other units. In August 1935 they included:

### **Pursuit Squadrons**

497th-500th, 509th-512th, 522nd-525th 527th-537th were constituted and allocated to the Organized Reserves in 1924, but I do not know if they were ever active.

None of these units are connected to Pursuit or Fighter units with the same numbers that were active in WW II.
