

## 747 COMMUNICATIONS SQUADRON



### **MISSION**

The mission of the 747 Communications Squadron is to deliver communications and informational capabilities to enable Headquarters Pacific Air Forces, 13th Air Force, 15 Wing, 67 tenant organizations and 13 geographically separated units to project peace and power throughout the Pacific and beyond. The squadron is located on the Hickam side of Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam. The squadron workforce includes approximately 200 enlisted, officers, contractors and civil service employees with 18 percent deployed at any given time.

The squadron maintains \$400,000 worth of antennas and satellites, provide technical support for over 500 Blackberrys, and manage a base network worth over \$16 million." In addition to the various programs and support functions the communications squadron provides to the Air Force community, two Airmen are directly responsible for the Navy installation land mobile radio requirements.
