Medium blue in chief eight mullets reversed chevronwise of two rows three and five argent and in fess two escutcheons azure fimbriated or, first bearing in pale throughout a "Flying Tiger" or striped brown armed and winged argent and on the second, a pile issuant from sinister throughout or, charged with a dagger fesswise of the like inflamed gules, all within a diminished bordure argent and over all a base nebuly gules fimbriated argent. (Approved, 20 May 1966)
