EMBLEM

Per fess nebuly Celeste and Azure; in chief, two stylized cubit arms grasping hands Or garnished Azure and detailed Gules; in base, a quill bendwise sinister Argent in saltire with a sword Yellow, grip Sable; all within a diminished bordure of the third. Attached below the disc a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border. **SIGNIFICANCE** Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The clasped hands, a symbol of union and friendship, bond unit personnel with students and also represent Inter-Americaism between the countries and the United States. The quill bonded with the sword symbolizes the joining of student-related support and discipline with training, and defines the key elements of the unit's mission. (Approved, 7 Nov 1995)
