EMBLEM

910 Materiel Squadron emblem: On a disc of light blue above a brown aircraft hangar with a dark blue entrance and foreground, and yellow pad, a yellow two bladed propeller horizontally, above which is a white parachute, a yellow ratchet wrench to viewer's left, and a blue derrick boom and pallet with a yellow load to viewer's right, around the disc a narrow red border with yellow blank scroll edged red above and below. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The emblem is symbolic of the squadron and its mission. Against a background of blue sky to represent our primary theater of operations, is a wrench and a derrick lifting supplies, indicating our primary mission. The propeller, parachute and hangar represents the primary units this squadron serves. (Approved, 11 Feb 1964)



910 Logistics Support Squadron emblem: On a disc Azure, three arrows bendwise in pale points ascending to sinister chief with three elongated tail arcing reversed downwards and to dexter Gules, surmounted in base by a rock formation supporting an American Bald Eagle, wings close Proper. All within a narrow border Sable. Attached above the disc a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "910TH LOGISTICS SUPPORT SQ" in Black letters. Attached below the disc a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "PROVIDING THE

ESSENTIALS" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The three arrows symbolize the three facets of logistics support, always progressing upwards. The eagle is our national symbol and represents strength and stands vigilant on rocky terrain. (Approved, 20 Jun 2001)

910 Logistics Support Squadron unofficial emblem provided by unit: an American Bald Eagle, black and white with bronze detail, reflects the freedom that the unit upholds and defends. This national symbol also represents strength and wisdom, and stands vigilant on rocky terrain. Its background is ultramarine blue to represent the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Three crimson arrows swoop skyward to symbolize the three facets of logistics support, always progressing upward. The yellow beak and talons represent the excellence required of Air Force personnel and exemplified by unit members. All elements reflect the unit's motto: PROVIDING THE ESSENTIALS.

910 Logistics Support Squadron unofficial emblem provided by unit: Elements of the proposed design are based on the 910th Logistics Support Group performance and leadership within the logistic field. The squadron is very proud of the accomplishments it has achieved throughout the years. All personnel agree that we should show our Esprit de Corps by having and proudly displaying our own squadron emblem.

- The upper scroll, 910th Logistics Support Sq., is the squadrons' designation.
- The lower scroll describes the squadrons' motto that the three elements in the squadron provide the essentials for others to accomplish assigned missions throughout the Air Force.
- The three arrows indicate the three sections within the squadron, with the movement of the squadron always progressing upward.
- The bald eagle and ground it stands on is significant to the freedom that we help maintain and enjoy in the United States
- The Air Force yellow boarder signifies the excellence required of Air Force personnel
- The Air Force blue signifies the sky as the primary theater for Air Force operations.
- This squadron emblem will help maintain the unit pride and morale with-in the 910th Logistics Support Squadron.
