The 1st Dental Squadron provides prompt, accessible and comprehensive dental care in support of global contingencies and prepares the Air Force's newest dental officers to eagerly accept this vital link in the Air Force mission. The 1 Dental Squadron provides treatment to 37,000 patients annually and operates a 31-treatment room facility and one satellite clinic, executing a \$513,000-dollar annual budget. The 1 Dental Squadron maintains dental health of over 400 active flying and 4,000 mobility personnel ensuring worldwide qualification for deployment.
