Constituted in the Regular Army on 1 August 1933, assigned to the Air Corps Technical School, and concurrently organized at Chanute Field, IL, with personnel from the Air Corps Technical School Detachment. Consolidated in 1934 with the 98th Aero Squadron (a WWI unit organized on 20 August 1917 at Kelly Field, TX; demobilized on 15 May 1919 at Mitchel Field, NY; reconstituted in 1934). Reorganized and redesignated 98th Service Squadron on 1 March 1935. Reorganized and redesignated 10th Air Base Squadron on 1 July 1936.
