Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 31 March 1924 as 15th Bombardment Wing Headquarters, assigned to the General Headquarters Reserve, and allotted to the Ninth Corps Area. Redesignated as Headquarters, 15th Bombardment Wing on 8 May 1929. Headquarters initiated by April 1930 at Boeing Field, Seattle, WA. Redesignated as Headquarters, 15th Transport Wing on 1 October 1933. Redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 15th Transport Wing on 1 September 1936. Inactivated on 2 March 1937 at Seattle by relief of personnel.
