Effective July 1, 1955, the 1500th Air Transport Group (ATG) became the 1502nd ATG per Military Air Transport Service General Order Number 105, dated 14 June 1955. The unit, at this time, had three Air Transport Squadrons (ATs): the 47th, flying C-97 aircraft; the 48th, flying 12 C-124A aircraft; and the 50th, flying 16 C-124A aircraft. Maintenance was provided by the 1502nd Maintenance Group and its associated squadrons.
