The 23rd Photo Squadron was inactivated on October 15, 1937, but the functions and personnel were merely transferred to the 4th Air Base Squadron.

The 23 Photo Section was organized in New York in 1918. It served overseas but did not engage in

combat. A new 23rd Photo Section was formed at Post Field, Okla., in 1922, the old unit having been demobilized in 1919. In 1924 the 23rd Photo Section of the World War was reconstituted and consolidated with the new organization. Transferred to March Field in 1927.
