Supply integrated the 25th Supply Group, Depot with 29 officers and 364 airmen assigned on 1 July 1950 to these organizations: Headquarters, 25th Supply Group, which supervised Group Squadrons, maintained liaison between squadrons and other 25th Air Depot Wing organizations, established supply priorities and performed supply inspection, disseminated information and supply policies, coordinated and assigned warehouse space, maintained records of storage space, etc. The supply integration included the 25th Ammunition Supply Squadron, Depot, which received, provided bulk storage and issued all ammunition and explosive portions of Class 39 (weapons, ammunition, explosives, warfare gasses, handling and emplacement equipment) at its duty training station, Tooele Ordnance Depot (Army), Tooele, Utah after it moved there 16 July 1950. Previously the Squadron had been at Kelly AFB, Texas, where it remained after the 25th Air Depot Wing moved to Ogden. Integrated also was the 25th Technical Supply Squadron, Depot, which received, stored and issued supplies, provided service for aircraft out of commission for

parts, provided corrosion and engine re-preservation control. Included in the integrated outfits was the 25th General Supply Squadron, Depot, which also received, stored and issued supplies, provided ration breakdowns, salvage and disposal services and furnished dry cleaning and laundry services.
