Lee Hall, VA, 1919-21
Inactive 1922-24

Active at Lee Hall, VA, as of June 1919 as the 29th Balloon Company and assigned to the Army Balloon School. Redesignated as Balloon Company No. 29 on 13 September 1921. Inactivated on 30 September 1921 at Lee Hall and 20th Balloon Company made Active Associate. Demobilized on 6 September 1922. Reconstituted in the Regular Army as the 29th Balloon Company on 24 March 1923 and 19th Airship Company made Active Associate. Designated mobilization training station was Fort Eustis, VA, 1923-24. Demobilized in 1924.
