In September 1997, the unit provided natural disaster assistance to Assisi, Italy, following an earthquake that left 4,000 homeless. In May 1998, the 31st RHF assisted following a massive mudslide in Siano, Italy. Vehicle operators used Bob-Cat loaders to clear an estimated 500 tons of mud.

The unit supported RED HORSE deployments to Bosnia during Operation JOINT ENDEAVOR, in the Balkans during Operations ALLIED FORCE/SUSTAIN HOPE, and in Southwest and South Central Asia during Operation ENDURING FREEDOM.

The 31st inactivated on 22 Mar 2004 and was replaced by the 712th Red Horse Flight.
