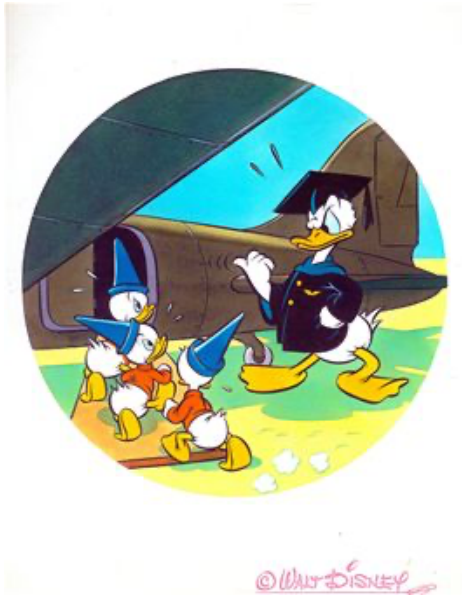

31 Troop Carrier Squadron emblem: Over and through a grayed dark red disc, light emerald green border, piped white, a caricatured bird light green, shaded blue, beak yellow, feet orange, in flight, carrying by the seat of the pants in its beak, a caricatured paratrooper, holding a brown and black "tommy" gun, proper; all between two large white cloud formations, shaded light green, in dexter chief and sinister base respectively. (Approved, 7 Dec 1943)
