The mission of the 42 Munitions Maintenance Squadron was to provide the 42nd Bomb Wing reliable munitions to support all wartime tasks. In addition to storing, maintaining and loading ordnance, the 42 MMS also performed intermediate-level maintenance on all test, handling and associated support equipment, including munitions trailers, aircraft weapons release systems and highly complex computers used to check out missiles and aircraft. The combined efforts of all squadron functions ensures that all assigned B-52Gs are properly configured and laded with the most reliable short range attack missiles and gravity weapons systems available.
