On a disc Azure, a dollar sign bend sinisterwise Vert, surmounted by a lightning bolt positioned the same Or, overall a flying eagle Proper, all within a narrow border Yellow. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "FINANCING THE FIGHT" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "43D COMPTROLLER FLIGHT" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue represents the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The dollar sign indicates the comptroller mission of the unit. The lightning bolt represents swift service to support mission accomplishment.
