### MISSION

44 Missile Security Squadron Primarily responsible for providing dedicated on-site security personnel for the 15 Minuteman missile Launch Control Facilities (LCFs) comprising the 66, 67, and 68 Strategic Missile Squadrons (66, 67, 68 SMS) of the 44 SMW. The 44 MSS staffed all Flight Security Controllers (FSCs), all two-person Alarm Response Teams (ARTs), and all three-person Security Response Teams (SRTs) [consisting of the relief shift FSC and ART], as well as field flight supervisory personnel.
