## OPERATIONS

The 44th Statistical Services Squadron set up its IBM punch-card accounting equipment in 1952. It began operation after a delay caused by electrical power incompatibilities. By 1954 CHAD functioned using the punch-card inventory control system. In January 1955, after all warehouses were built, a material conveyor "Towveyer" system was installed throughout the

complex to save time and labor. The electrical motor-driven endless chain system moved up to 200 four-wheel material carts through the sixty-eight storage sheds into the packing-shipping-receiving buildings. This system cost \$247,389 and was the first in Europe.
