OPERATIONS

WESTAF inactivated the 47th and 55th Air Transport Squadrons on 25 March 1960 as part of Operation CHECKERBOARD. This reorganization accomplished the phase-out of the command's aging C-97 fleet from active duty. The C-97s were assigned to Air National Guard units. This transfer left the 1501 st Air Transport Wing with two C-124 squadrons (75th and 85th) and one C-133 squadron

(84th). After about 18 months at this reduced strength, Travis added the 44th Air Transport Squadron in anticipation of acquiring 17 C-135B Stratolifters as part of MATS' airlift modernization program.
