EMBLEM



The emblem is symbolic of the squadron and its mission. Against a background of deep blue (to represent the sky) and three stars (to indicate the three primary functions of the organization; security, law enforcement and administration), a red shield symbolizes valor and a mailed hand grasping a sword indicates readiness to defend. The emblem bears the Air Force colors, ultramarine blue and golden yellow, and the national colors of red, white and blue. (Approved, 2 Mar 1962)
