6 October 1948; An engine fire causes the crash in Waycross, Georgia, of a Boeing B-29-100-BW Superfortress, *45-21866*, of the 3150th Electronics Squadron, United States Air Force, shortly after takeoff from Robins Air Force Base, killing 9 of 13 men aboard, including 3 RCA engineers. Four parachuted to safety.
