OPERATIONS

On July 30, 1951, the 3338th, 3339th, 3340th and 3341st Student Squadrons were activated at Amarillo Air Force Base. This was the first of the organizations that make up the present 3320th Tech. Training Group. The 11th of September was the opening date for the first classes. New personnel were continually being assigned to the Group during the remainder of the year. The first jet fighters were scheduled to arrive in September and the first B-47 jet bombers in early 1952.

The flow of students rose gradually to 9700 men by May, 1953, but due to Air Force requirements decreased later in the year. In January, 1954, entries picked up again. Throughout the period of

intensive training the overall program was subjected to constant revision, which resulted in changes in the overall training concept.

By adopting new methods and keeping abreast of new technical procedures, the Group continues to turn out superbly trained personnel to service the Air Force's jet aircraft.
