OPERATIONS

On 26 August 1948, Air Training Command organized the 3750th Basic Training Wing. The wing consisted of five major organizations: the 3750th Station Hospital, the 3750th Air Base Group, the 3750th Maintenance and Supply Group, the 3750th Basic Training Group, and the 3760th Basic Training Group.

In January 1949, HQ ATC informed the 3750th Basic Training Wing that an airplane mechanics school would relocate to Sheppard from Keesler AFB. This announcement was especially

fortuitous, since by January 1949 the flow of basic trainees had begun to slow. The number of new recruits had dropped by almost half, from 3,300 in January to 1,700 in February.

1 Apr 1949 Air Training Command discontinued the 3750th Basic Training Wing and, in its place, established the 3750th Technical Training Wing.
