## EMBLEM

6 Airborne Missile Maintenance Squadron emblem: On a blue disc within a narrow gold border in pale a caricature of a white dog (Snoopy) nose, eye, and ears black, walking on his hind legs on a white cloud in dexter base, his head surmounting a like cloud that is issuant fesswise from sinister chief. The dog is wearing a gold collar and carrying, under his dexter arm the nose of a white missile shaded gray, and under his sinister arm a screwdriver handle gold and blade white. Emblem between two blue scrolls edged gold, lower scroll inscribed in gold capital letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The emblem is symbolic of the Squadron. Against the background of the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations, the caricatured dog, the squadron's mascot, represents the high standards maintained by the squadron in accomplishing its mission, indicated by the screwdriver and airborne missile. The emblem bears the Air Force colors, golden yellow and ultramarine blue. (Approved, 17 Nov 1966)
