Celeste, a cross couped Gules surmounted by a compass rose of eight Or shaded Azure braced by a serpent Sable; all within a diminished bordure of the fourth. Attached above the disc a Gray scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "GLOBAL MEDICINE" in Blue letters. Attached below the disc a Gray scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "6TH

MEDICAL OPERATIONS SQUADRON." **SIGNIFICANCE**: Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The snake wrapping indicates the medical science logo – the Caduceus. The compass points represent global medicine, our worldwide operations and medical readiness; the red cross is the universal sign for medical readiness.
