Constituted in the Organized Reserve 15 October 1921 as Headquarters, Sixth Army Air Service, assigned to the Sixth Army and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Headquarters initiated on 26 February 1923 at San Antonio, TX. Withdrawn from the Eighth Corps Area 13 June 1924 and allotted to the Ninth Corps Area. Headquarters reorganized in 1924 at San Francisco, CA. Withdrawn from the Organized Reserve on 5 September 1928 and inactivated at San Francisco.
