TB-29s of 6 Tow Target Squadron were out of commission in much of reporting period due maintenance problems and lack of spare parts. 1956

For overseas training, six of these new airplanes went to the 6th TTS at Johnson AB, Japan in mid-1957. Two airplanes and crews deployed for two weeks at a time to fighter squadron locations at Clark AB, PI; Andersen AFB, Guam; Naha AB, Okinawa; and Itazuki AB, Misawa AB and YokotaAB, the last three in Japan. The 6th TTS was inactivated by late 1957 and the B-57E resources were assigned as a flight of the 8th Bomb Squadron, 3rd Bomb Wing at Johnson AB.

6th Tow Target Squadron was reduced to one officer one enlisted status with its mission being taken up by 3rd Air Base Group.
