OPERATIONS

To assist Ogden with its growing area communications workload, USAF activated the 7th Communications Construction Squadron at Hill AFB 25 August 1951. AMC reassigned it to the 3108th Communications Group at Rome Air Force Depot, New York 16 January 1955, but left its seven officers and 149 airmen stationed at Hill AFB.

Further development of the GEEIA organization came on 1 January 1959 when an old tenant at Hill AFB, the 7th Communications Construction Squadron, was inactivated. Concurrently, AMC designated and organized the 2870th GEEIA Squadron, assigned to the Ogden GEEIA Region.
