Antisubmarine patrols, Dec 1941-0ct 1942. Combat in ETO, 23 May 1944-20 Apr 1945.

With pilot production down dramatically, the command reassessed the need for four flying training squadrons at each UPT base and concluded two would do. Accordingly, on 1 Oct 1992, ATC inactivated the following units: the 43d and and 49th Flying Training Squadrons at Columbus AFB, MS; the 84th and 86th Flying Training Squadrons at Laughlin AFB, TX; the 7th and 26th at Vance AFB, OK; and the 33d at Reese AFB, TX. That left one T-37 squadron and one T-38 squadron at each UPT wing. As each wing implemented specialized undergraduate pilot training, ATC intended to reactivate one of the squadrons to serve as the T-1A squadron.
