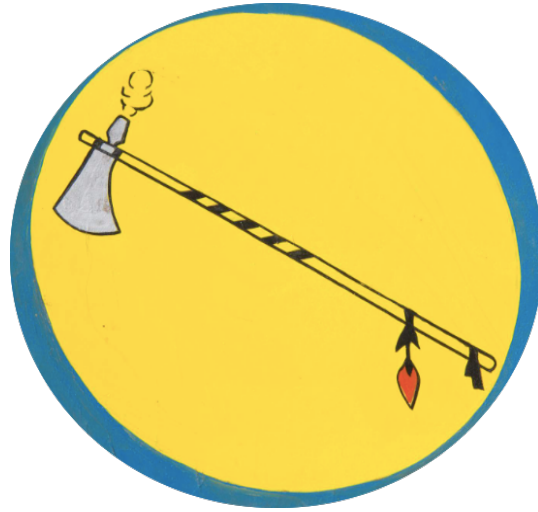

Constituted in the Regular Army on 6 February 1923 as the 51st School Squadron and assigned to the 13th School Group. Designated Active Associate was the Air Service Technical School 1923-27. Allotted to the Sixth Corps Area on 28 February 1927. Activated at Brooks Field, TX, 1 August 1927, relieved from assignment to the 13th School Group, and assigned to the 11th School Group. Relieved from assignment to the 11th School Group on 15 July 1931. Inactivated on 31 August 1931 at Brooks Field. Activated on 1 September 1931 at Maxwell Field, AL, and attached to the Air Corps Tactical School. Reorganized and redesignated 51st Attack Squadron on 1 March 1935, assigned to the 3rd Attack Group, and attached to the Air Corps Tactical School. Inactivated on 1 September 1936 at Maxwell Field, AL.
